Public Transportation

Please call Port Authority of Allegheny County at **412-442-2000** or visit their website at: www.portauthority.org for appropriate bus and schedule.

Driving From 376W (formally 279S):

- Take PA-28 N via EXIT 1D toward Chestnut Street/East Ohio Street/Etna.
- Take the East Ohio Street exit on the left toward I-279 N.
- Turn left onto East Ohio Street
- Turn right onto Middle Street
- North Side Christian Health Center is on the right.

Driving from 376E

- Take exit 70C to merge onto I-279 N/Fort Duquesne Bridge toward North Shore
- Take exit 1D for East Ohio Street toward Etna N.
- Follow signs for I-279 N/East Ohio Street
- Turn left onto East Ohio Street
- Turn right onto Middle Street
- North Side Christian Health Center is on the right.

Driving From 279N

- Take the East Street exit, EXIT 2B, toward PA-28N.
- Stay straight to go onto East Street.
- Turn right onto Suismon Street.
- Take the 1st left onto Middle Street.



There is a handicapped accessible paved lot for patient parking; look for signs.

Parking is also available in the Pittsburgh Parking Authority metered lot on the corner of Middle Street and Foreland Street.

Driving From 376W (formally 279S):

- Take the ramp onto I-376 E
- Continue onto I-279 N
- Take exit 3 for Hazlett Street
- Turn left onto East Street
- Turn right onto Mt Pleasant Road
- Northview Heights Health Center will be on the right.

Driving from 376E

- Take I-376 W/U.S. 30 W
- Take exit 70C to merge onto I-279 N/Fort Duquesne Bridge toward North Shore
- Take exit 3 for Hazlett Street
- Turn left onto East Street
- Turn right onto Mt. Pleasant Road
- Northview Heights Health Center will be on the right.

Driving From 279N

- Take I-279 S (signs for Pittsburgh)
- Take exit 4 for Venture Street
- Turn left onto East Street
- Turn left onto Mt. Pleasant Road

Appointments

To schedule an appointment to be seen by a medical or dental provider at the main clinic please call 412-321-4001. To schedule an appointment at the Northview Heights Clinic please call 412-322-7500.

All patients should arrive 30 minutes before their scheduled appointments to allow time for check-in and registration. Bring your insurance card (or proof of income), ID, co-pay, and list of medications to your appointment. *If you are late for your appointment, you may be asked to reschedule.*

Fees

- **All health insurances are accepted.**
- Discounts for many services are offered depending upon family size and income. You may apply for a discount at the Front Desk.
- **Payment is expected at the time of service.** You may pay by cash, check, or credit/debit card (MasterCard or Visa).

Services

Primary Care

Includes: Physical exams, immunizations, cancer screenings, disease management, small in-house procedures, gynecological exams, Healthy Women Program, Hepatitis C clinic, counseling, and sick visits.

Pediatrics

Includes: Well child visits, immunizations, vision, hearing and lead screenings.

Dental

Includes: dental exams, emergency care, x-rays, cleanings, fluoride treatments, restoration (fillings), extractions, prosthetics (dentures/partials), endodontic (root canals), and repairs.

Laboratory

Includes: Urine dips, pregnancy tests, infectious disease screenings, and other routine labs.

Mental Health Counseling

Includes: Individual, group, and family counseling and treatment for mental health and addiction disorders. *(Provided through our partnership with a mental health agency)*

Pharmacy

Includes: Home delivery, medication reconciliation, and patient assistance program (for patients without prescription insurance). *(Provided through our partnership with The Medicine Shoppe and The University of Pittsburgh School of Pharmacy)*

Health Education

Includes: Diabetes, Smoking Cessation, and Nutrition

Telephone Messages

For non-emergency care, please follow the menu prompts and leave a message in the appropriate box. Please leave your name, your telephone number and a brief description explaining your needs. Your phone call will be returned at our earliest opportunity.

Medical Records

Transfers to NSCHC

If you received medical treatment at another facility and would like your medical records transferred to NSCHC, you **must** complete a “[Release of Information Form](#)” in order for the North Side Christian Health Center to obtain your medical records from that facility. You will need to include the complete name, address, phone and fax number of the other facility, as well as the dates you were seen.

Transfers from NSCHC to Another Practice

If you request that your medical records be sent from the North Side Christian Health Center to another physician or practice, you **must** sign a “[Release of Information Form](#)” instructing the Center what information you are requesting and where it should be sent.

Transfers from NSCHC to Non-Medical Facility

If you want copies of your records, you **must** sign a “[Release of Information Form](#)” for yourself or for a non-medical facility, there is a **\$30 fee** for this service. Release of Information Forms can be downloaded from our website at www.nschc.org under the Patients & Visitors tab.
