PATIENT CHOICE AWARD

Michelle was continually named by NSCHC patients as providing exceptional care as a therapist in the Behavioral Health Department. Her nomination to PACHC's annual award recognition was selected out of dozens of nominations from across the state.

FROM THE CEO

When the health emergency was lifted this past May, there was a collective sigh of relief that the pandemic was finally over. Although it may be true that the world has moved on from Covid, its impact is still felt by those who lost someone, are still experiencing health impacts of the virus, missed significant education opportunities, and by those who lost their job and are still trying to find their footing. Many who were eligible for Medicaid during the pandemic, may find that they have been un-enrolled and



no longer qualify. Others may have lost their insurance coverage when they became unemployed. North Side Christian Health Center (NSCHC) is ready to care for anyone who needs medical, dental or behavioral health care, regardless of ability to pay or life circumstances.

Supporting our neighbors and our patients on the Northside and the surrounding communities is not new for NSCHC. The Center was founded 30 years ago to fill a health care gap for those who had no access to insurance because they were unemployed or did not qualify (remember when pre-existing conditions excluded people from health insurance when they were most in need?). In 1993, three young physicians, Dr. Holt, Dr. Guy, and Dr. Wahrenberger created a health center for everyone, regardless of ability to pay, where whole-person care was provided with compassion and without judgement. Their vision became a reality and has touched thousands of lives.

NSCHC's focus is and will always be on caring and supporting our patients. For nearly two years, we have provided a satisfaction survey to every patient completing an appointment. While we love hearing how we have made a positive impact, we also take patient feedback to heart and are continuously working to improve access to services. For patients, this means less wait time to get an appointment and better continuity of care.

This year, NSCHC received recognition for its focus on patient care: NSCHC was certified by the National Committee on Quality Assurance as a Patient-Centered Medical Home. Recognition confirms that NSCHC has the tools and resources to provide its patients with the high-quality care at the right time. Michelle Saldutte, a therapist at NSCHC since 2020, was also recognized by the Pennsylvania Association of Community Health Centers with a "Patient Choice" award for her excellent patient care.

This fall, NSCHC celebrated 30 years of serving patients on the Northside. Regardless if you were able to attend the annual gala, we thank you for your engagement, your encouragement and your on-going partnership. Our mission, our facilities, and our services would not be possible without you.

ORGANIZATIONAL DESCRIPTION

MISSION

Motivated to live our Christian principles, the mission of the North Side Christian Health Center is to provide whole-person primary health care to underserved persons on the Northside and surrounding neighborhoods. We envision a community where people of all backgrounds are actively engaged in maintaining a healthy lifestyle.

ORGANIZATION HISTORY

North Side Christian Health Center (NSCHC) was founded in 1993 when three physicians, Dr. Todd Wahrenbeger, Dr. Mark Guy and Dr. Daniel Holt, answered a spiritual call to live their Christian principles through healing work.

One primary contributor to the early development of the health center was Allegheny Center Alliance Church. Additional supporters were Mercy Hospital, Global Links, and Ascension Church. PNC Bank provided a donated storefront on East Ohio Street, illustrating the true definition of a "community" health center. The interior modifications were made with help from contractors and church volunteers, converting the space into a functioning health center; by installing exam rooms, a lab, and offices. Initially, volunteers provided health services and office support. As the needs grew and the patient volume increased, physicians and support staff were employed to keep pace with the community demands.





In 2008, NSCHC became a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC), and moved to its current location at 816 Middle Street. In 2011, NSCHC established a dental clinic at the Middle Street office and in 2020 launched the Behavioral Health department; fulfilling the vision of providing whole-person care. Core services are provided at the main location at 816 Middle Street in the Northside of Pittsburgh, a federally designated Medically Underserved Area and health provider shortage area. A satellite office is

located in the Northview Heights Housing Community. NSCHC is the only FQHC located in a public housing complex in the region.

SERVICE LINE UPDATES

NSCHC is a "one-stop" health center for patients' primary and preventative care – offering primary care, dental services and behavioral health care to all ages. The three departments collaborate together to organize community integrated care days, provide referrals when a patient needs care in more than one department, and to deliver care for the mind, body, and spirit as envisioned when NSCHC was founded. Additionally, NSCHC continues to offer pharmacy consults and has expanded the social determinants of health program to address the social and economic needs of the patients.

MEDICAL DEPARTMENT:

Family medicine physicians and the pediatrician provide care on the North Side and at Northview Heights. During 2023, Dr. Andrea Schaeffer joined the department and Dr. Dallas Malzi was named Chief Medical Officer. Notable activities and accomplishments include the following:

- The medical team now includes three family medicine physicians, one pediatrician, one nurse practitioner, and one physician assistant.
- The uninsured vaccine program expanded to include vaccines for flu, polio, tetanus, meningitis, pneumonia, hepatitis, measles, mumps, rubella and varicella.



- NSCHC Maintained the partnership with the Latino Community Center to provide family-centered care that is sensitive to the needs of immigrant and refugee patients in the community.
- Training and education for future community health care providers continues. Learners and trainees come from UPMC McKeesport, UPMC Shadyside, Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh, University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine and Duquesne University.
- A focus has been to improve the partnership with the Greater Pittsburgh Community Food Bank to provide food boxes to families with food insecurity during their appointments.
- In 2023, hundreds of books were distributed to pediatric patients to encourage early childhood literacy through the Reach Out and Read program.

DENTAL DEPARTMENT:

The dental department, completely renovated in 2020 and using state-ofthe-art equipment, accepts commercial insurance, Medicaid and those individuals without insurance. Notable activities and accomplishments include the following:

- Provided integrated pediatric visits at both NSCHC locations: children may receive medical well visits and dental care on the same day.
- Cared for hundreds of refugees and non-English speaking immigrants.
- Hosted a "Dental Sealant Day" to bolster cavity prevention in children.



BEHAVIORAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT:

The department, which opened in 2020, is comprised of a psychologist, licensed clinical social workers, and a licensed professional counselor (bi-lingual in Spanish). Patients may conduct their visits in person or virtually. Notable activities and accomplishments include the following:

- Michelle Saldutte, LCSW, Behavioral Health Therapist was awarded the 2023 PACHC Patient Choice Award.
- Reconvened the annual conference addressing trauma and healing which was attended by approximately 150 professionals and community partners and featured local and global panelists.
- Partnered with AHEC to staff a Behavioral
 Health Specialist/Community Liaison position onsite at Light of Life to assist with
 coordinating community based mental health services among those with housing
 vulnerabilities.




